
BEFORE USE

Unscrew the aerator and allow the water to run freely for 5 minutes. Then replace the aerator and tighten. It is recommended that you clean the aerator periodically. To do this, remove the aerator, then rinse it with running water until any loose debris are cleared.







TROUBLE SHOOTING

Problem	Cause	Action
Leaks underneath handle.	Cartridge is loose or damaged.	Make sure retaining nut is fully tighten. Adjust or replace cartridge if necessary.
Aerator leaks or has inconsistent water flow pattern.	Aerator is dirty or mystified.	Unscrew aerator to check rubber packing or replace aerator.
Water will not shut off completely.	Dirty or worn out plastic washer in the cartridge.	Adjust or replace cartridge.

CLEANING AND CARE

Clean the faucet often with a soft cloth to keep it looking like new. For heavy cleaning you can use mild liquid detergents or non-abrasive liquid polisher. Rinse with water and dry with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, steel wool and harsh chemicals as these will dull the finish and void your warranty.

LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY

INOLAV provides its customers with an extensive warranty as a result of our excellent workmanship and high quality components used in our products.

Mechanical warranty: A limited lifetime warranty is provided on all mechanical parts to be free from manufacturing defects in materials and workmanship under normal use for as long as the original purchaser owns their home.

Finish warranty: A 5-year warranty is provided on all INOLAV faucet finishes to the original purchaser against manufacturing defects in materials and workmanship.

At its sole discretion, INOLAV will repair or replace any part or finish that proves to be defective in material and/or workmanship under normal installation, use and service.








PARTS INCLUDED


Before your installation please make sure you have received the parts indicated below.






STEP 1

Screw waterlines into corresponding line connectors of faucet body. Make sure o-ring goes into the line connector. Do not over tighten.



STEP 2

Secure faucet to counter top or basin using the mounting kit as described in the figure. 1-Screw threaded rods into faucet body. 2-Fit square washer into groove of faucet body and insert faucet into faucet hole. 3-Align rubber and steel washer, and tighten the fixing nuts using spanner.



STEP 3

Screw water lines into corresponding water supply lines in the wall using a 5/8" wrench. Do not over tighten. Check for leakage.
